#### **Primaries: March 2013**

**Fellowship Examinations**

The staggered fellowship examination for the Part 1 was held on 28<sup>th</sup> March 2013 at three centres in Abuja, Enugu and Lagos. The MCQ format was used and conducted successfully. A total of 64 candidates sat for the examinations and 31 of them passed the screening exam (48.4%). This made them eligible to proceed with the main fellowship examinations.

The April/May fellowship examinations were held between 29<sup>th</sup> April and 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2013. A total of 89 candidates registered for the examinations at both Part I and Part II levels (Part I – 64 and Part II – 25), the success rates were 39.1% and 56.0%. These results had been considered and approved by the College Senate.
