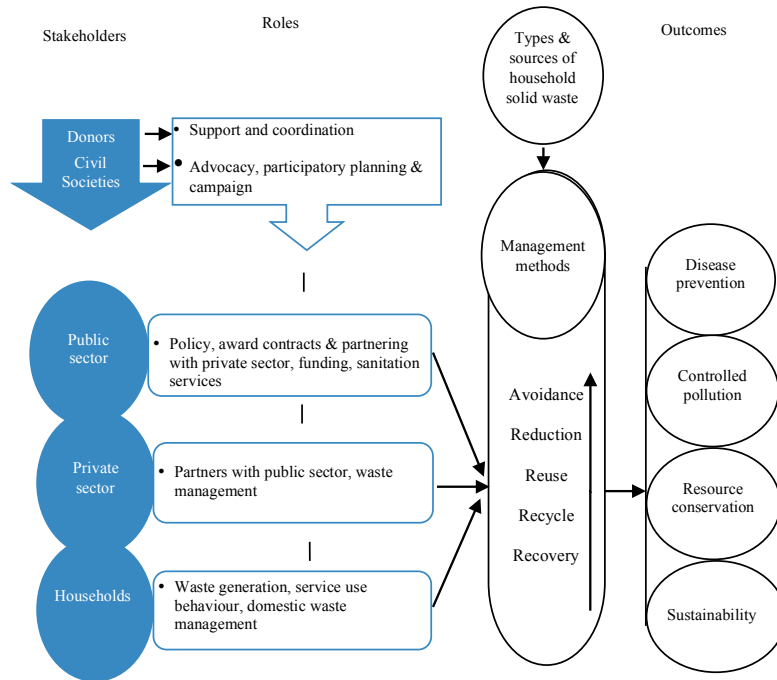


Figure 1: Framework of household solid waste management
