### Seven new records of butterfly taxa (Lepidoptera: Papilionoidea) from Benin

## OBSERVATIONS

In order to improve data on biodiversity in the Republic of Benin in West Africa, a team of seven entomologists, including one Beninese, spent twenty one days, from 22 October to 14 November 2017, exploring some natural areas in southern Benin. All told, 207 species were collected, seven of which were recorded for the first time in Benin. Six areas were visited: Pahou Forest (6.3826 2.2289); Kpetou Sacred Forest (6.4363 1.8895); Niaouli Forest (6.7453 2.1272) (Fig. 1); Ko (= Lama) Forest (6.9476 2.1322); Lokoli Forest (7.0757 2.3175); Ouidah coastal area (6.3426 2.0705). Identifications were made using Larsen (2005). Specimens were also compared with those in a number of collections in Europe. The seven taxa new to Benin are given in Table 1 below.
