

Giant Communicating Hydrocele in a 36-year-old Nigerian Man

In the article titled “GIANT COMMUNICATING HYDROCELE IN A 36-YEAR-OLD NIGERIAN MAN”, published on pages 212-214 issue 2 volume 30, March-April 2021 in Nigerian journal of medicine the words “a symptomatic hernia or hydrocele” were miswritten as “asymptomatic hernia or hydrocele” on page 212 under INTRODUCTION.

The correct statement should read as “Persistent patency of all or a portion of the PV within the inguinal canal may, but does not always result in a symptomatic hernia or hydrocele.”

The words “he was found to have a huge” were miswritten as “he was Found to have had a huge” on page 213 under CASE PRESENTATION.

The correct statement should read as “ At the presentation in our centre, he was found to have a huge left hemi-scrotal swelling 22cm x 18cm x 8cm [Figure 1].”
